Description

This report justifies the cancellation of deliverable D1.2, originally entitled "Crossborder Iberian Youth Mobility Action (Valverde & Burguillos — Vila Viçosa)". As recorded in the project's "History of Changes" (Version 2.0, March/April 2026), this activity has been cancelled due to circumstances beyond the consortium's control.

The cancellation was necessary due to the impossibility of obtaining a project extension from EACEA and school calendar constraints that prevented the displacement of Spanish students to Portugal within the project deadline. The target group (youth) is still addressed through the modified deliverable D1.3 (Youth Encounter in Burguillos and Valverde, 28 May 2026). The modification was communicated to and accepted by the Project Officer.

The activity was designed as a cross-border youth mobility exchange bringing together 53 young people (aged 15-17) from Burguillos del Cerro and Valverde de Burguillos (Spain) to Vila Viçosa (Portugal). The visit aimed to foster European identity, cultural exchange and the development of leadership skills among rural youth. The programme included guided tours of the historical heritage of Vila Viçosa, workshops on European values, and recreational activities.

To ensure that the project's youth-related objectives are still met, the following measures were taken:

Reorientation of D1.3: The original two-way exchange was transformed into a one-way visit of 43 Portuguese young people to Spain (28 May 2026). This activity maintained the focus on European identity, digital heritage and cross-border cooperation. The visit combined guided tours of historical heritage with exposure to innovative digital tools, aiming to promote European identity, digital skills and a sense of belonging to rural areas.

Programme and activities carried out

- Visit to CITLab – 3D Printing Centre (Jerez de los Caballeros): Students learned about additive manufacturing technologies and their applications. The training course offer (basic, intermediate and advanced levels) was presented.
- Guided tour of Jerez de los Caballeros: Walking tour of the historic centre, highlighting cultural heritage as a driver of territorial development.
- Visit to Valverde de Burguillos – "Water Culture" Project: The students explored the local hydraulic and ethnographic heritage project, with institutional reception and participation of local associations.
- Fellowship lunch: fostering informal exchange with members of the Valverde de Burguillos youth association and the Activa Valverde association, as well as strengthening personal ties between delegations.

Involvement of Portuguese students: The alternative activity involved students from the Public Secondary School Hortense De Castro (Vila Viçosa), who participated in a visit to the CITLab in Jerez de los Caballeros and to Valverde de Burguillos.

Establishment of educational collaboration: The visit resulted in a stable educational collaboration between the Portuguese school and CITLab, with free accommodation offered by Valverde de Burguillos University Residence.
